

"Request a Quote" - Custom Web Forms

Customizable Web forms allow your customers to request a printing quote through your company's website. The contents of the request are e-mailed to you, and they can be imported directly into the Presstimator as a New Quote. Once this data has been imported, click on the 'Load All Defaults' button to have a Quote calculated in seconds. Custom web forms can also be used internally as a convenient way for salespeople to enter the initial job specs.
